Since the death of President Chavez on March 5, 2013, Venezuela has experienced a deteriorating economy, including shortages and skyrocketing inflation.

On December 6 an opposition coalition won the majority of seats in the National Assembly. Although Chavista Nicolas Maduro continues his term as president of the Bolivarian Republic, a tumultuous and challenging period lies ahead.

What is the legacy of seventeen years of socialism, what led to this devastating electoral defeat for the left, and what options exist for the future?
