Héctor Perla, Jr is Senior Research Fellow at the Council on Hemispheric Affairs and a fellow in the American Political Science Association's Congressional Fellowship Program, Washington DC.

He will discuss "Soft Coups in Latin America: The Right Wing's Response to

21st Century Socialism." He will explain how the Latin American right-wing and its Washington allies are perverting longstanding social justice demands (against corruption, human rights violations, poverty) to destabilize and overthrow progressive governments through non-electoral and undemocratic means.

Reed Fromer is a vocalist, bandleader, songwriter, demo producer, film scorer, and choir director. He was the recipient of the Martin Luther King, Jr. Humanitarian Award, presented by the Marin County Human Rights Commission, for his educational work on civil rights and social justice.

He is a three-time "Song of the Year" winner of the Northern California Songwriters' Association Annual Playoffs.

As a chorus teacher and choir director, he facilitates a joyous introduction to music for suburban and inner city youth.

Reed generously carries on the Fromer tradition of entertaining at our annual dinner.
