**Dan Kovalik is author of the new, highly acclaimed book *The Plot to Scapegoat Russia: How the CIA and the Deep State have Conspired to Vilify Russia*. Copies will be available at the dinner.**

**Guest speaker Daniel Kovalik** will discuss "A Tale of Two Countries: Colombia & Venezuela," and will compare and contrast events in those countries and how they are being covered in the media.

Kovalik is a long-time labor and human rights lawyer and teaches International Human Rights Law at the University of Pittsburgh School of Law. He has worked on Alien Tort Claims Act cases against The Coca-Cola Company, Drummond and Occidental Petroleum – cases of egregious human rights abuses in Colombia. The Christian Science Monitor, referring to his defending Colombian unionists under threat of assassination, describes Mr. Kovalik as "one of the most prominent

defenders of Colombian workers in the United States." Mr. Kovalik received the David W. Mills Mentoring Fellowship from Stanford University School of Law and was the recipient of the Project Censored Award for exposing the unprecedented killing of trade unionists in Colombia. He has written extensively on the issue of international human rights and U.S. foreign policy and has lectured throughout the world on these subjects.
